1) Remarks regarding numbers 1 and 2 of the questionnaire:

Section II

2. If the statements in the questionnaire, the applicant's refusal to sign the declaration as per Annex 3 or facts that have become known by other means make it appear doubtful whether the applicant is prepared to defend the basic liberal democratic order as defined by the German Constitution and the Bavarian Constitution, these doubts must be cleared before the applicant can be employed. The means to this end are particularly
 - an enquiry with the Federal Office for the Protection of the Constitution to determine whether facts are known that give reason for misgivings concerning the employment. The Federal Office for the Protection of the Constitution is obliged to answer enquiries of this type without delay. If pertinent information exists, the information disclosed shall be restricted to facts that can be used before court. The Ministry of the Interior is responsible for providing this information.
 - an enquiry with the Federal Commissioner for the Documents of the State Security Service of the former German Democratic Republic, with the applicant's agreement,
 - an enquiry with the Central Evidence and Documentation Institution of the State Administration of Justice, with the applicant's agreement.
3. For applicants from the acceding territory^{b)} who were born before January 15, 1972, in alteration of no. 2, due to possible activities for the Ministry of State Security or the Bureau for National Security of the former GDR, the documents of the State Security Service of the former Democratic Republic shall be requested in all cases, with the applicant's agreement.
7. The Bavarian Ministry of the Interior compiles an Index of the Most Important Extremistic or Extremistically Influenced Organizations and of the Most Important Mass Organizations/Social Organizations in the Former GDR up to 1989/90 and publishes it in the „Allgemeines Ministerialblatt“^{c)} and the „Bayerischer Staatsanzeiger“. The Ministry of the Interior updates the Index at need.

Annex 3

Declaration

Based on the briefing handed to me on the duty to be faithful to the German Constitution in the civil service, I hereby explicitly declare that I affirm the principles of the basic liberal democratic order as defined by the German Constitution, and that I am willing to show by my entire demeanour at all times that I adhere to the basic liberal democratic order as defined by the German Constitution, and to stand for its preservation.

I explicitly affirm that I do not support any efforts directed against the basic democratic order or one of its above mentioned fundamental principles, and furthermore, that I am not and was not at a member of any organization directed against these. I acknowledge receipt of the Index of Organizations Adversary to the Constitution and the Most Important Mass Organizations / Social Organizations in the Former GDR up to 1989/90.

I fully realize

- that by giving false or incomplete information or by omitting information in the employment procedure, I risk not being employed, or that a renewal of my appointment may be revoked, or that my employment contract may be rescinded,
- that if I violate against these official duties and my duty to be faithful to the Constitution, I must reckon with an extraordinary notice of dismissal.
